

ABOUT THE AUTHOR



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A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR

WHY DID YOU WRITE NAVIGATING MONEY, MARKETS & MEN? WHAT WAS YOUR INSPIRATION?

I went through a horrendous experience at the end of my marriage. I had bailed us out of financial disaster after financial disaster over the 23 years. Then he was arrested, which completely blindsided me. When I read that the fastest growing cohort of homeless people was women in their 50s, I was horrified. I could have been one of them except for the fact that I had a well-paying job and some small but significant investments. I didn't want to write about my tragedy or even throw my former husband under a bus. That was private business. But I thought if I could pass on what I had learned about money management and emotional resilience to younger women, fewer might fall into the trap of financial disaster at the wrong end of their working lives. I grew up in the '60s. I believed in the feminist movement. So, while some things have gotten better, a lot simply hasn't. Wages and opportunities are still unequal, and women are still bearing the brunt of financial inequality through discrimination, marriage breakdowns and domestic violence. I want to inspire action to improve the situation of women, by women. It's not about being better. It's about being equal. We can make better partnerships and a better society if we work positively together.
