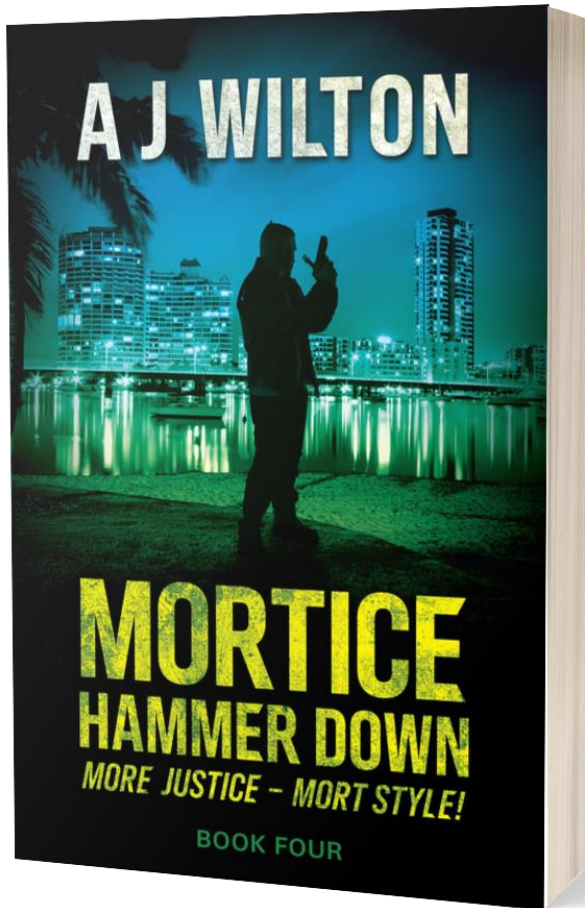


Mortice: Hammer Down

ABOUT THE AUTHOR

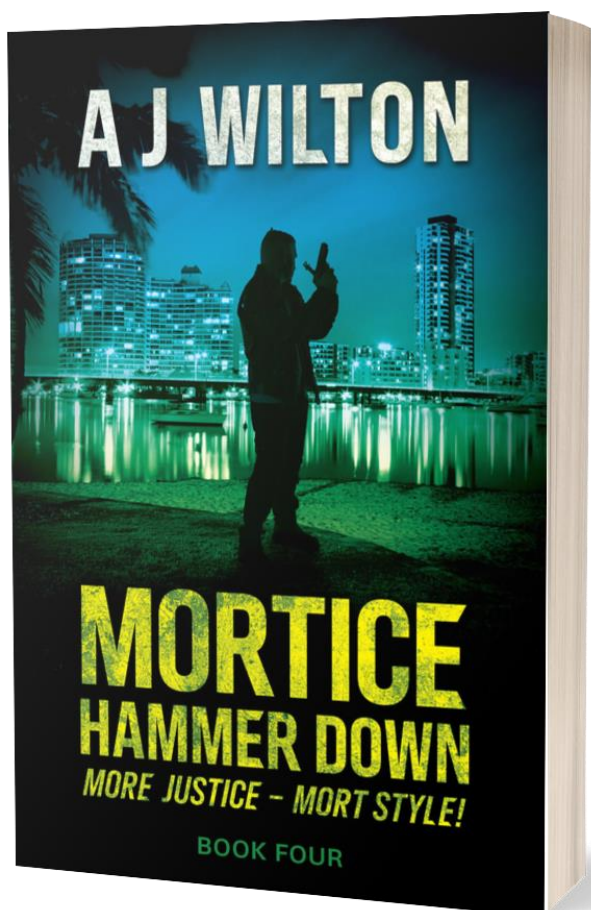

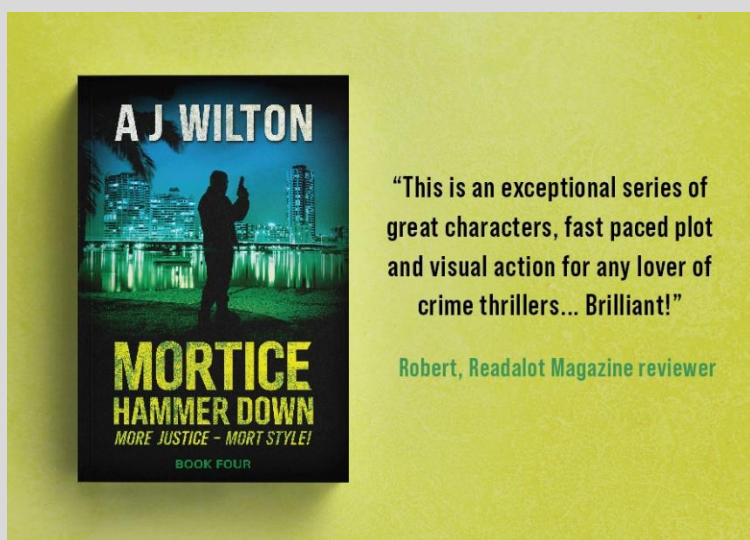
Yes – that’s fun!
