


Since childhood, Justin aspired to become an author. He was creative and loved books, but life took him in a different direction. He became a father and built a successful career as an analyst.

A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR

WHAT IS THE MOST DIFFICULT PART OF YOUR WRITING PROCESS?

Having a finished book is the hardest part. I can write the entire manuscript but to get to the point where I can say it is finished is very difficult. I feel like they are living and never truly finished. To be able to handover a finished product and say this is complete is near impossible.

HOW DO YOU SELECT CHARACTERS NAMES?

Sometimes the character name comes to me with the story, other times I will look to family or friends or even reach out to others for ideas on social media. Finding the right name to fit the character is so important that this can often be the hardest part of the story.

DOES WRITING ENERGISE OR EXHAUST YOU?

It is a bit of both, when writing I am energised and can write all night without stopping which leaves me totally exhausted for all the other commitments in my life, like work. So, I need to control myself and try and be planned with my writing which can be frustrating. I write for 3-4 hours a day but would love to be able to do it full-time. I have so many ideas at any one time that I currently have 4 finished books, about another 6 in writing and outline for another 20. Lots of ideas to get down on the page.
