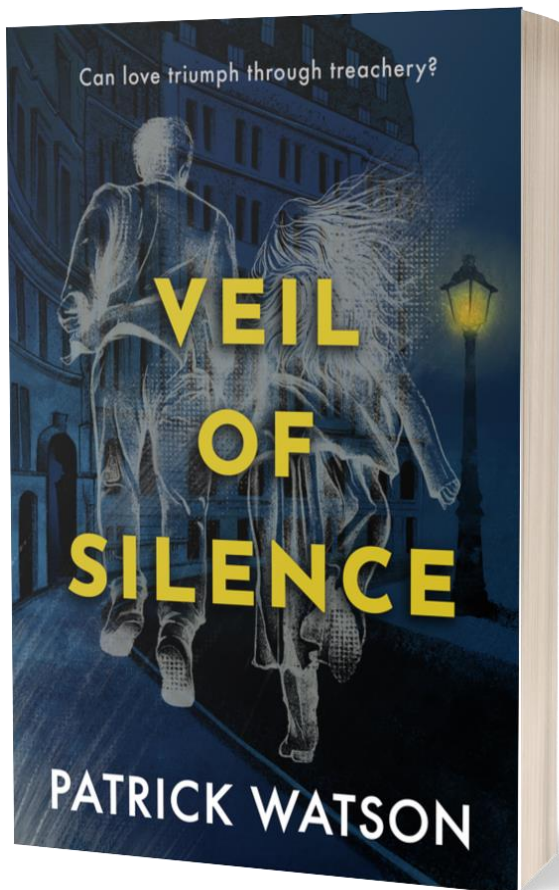


VEIL OF SILENCE

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ABOUT THE AUTHOR

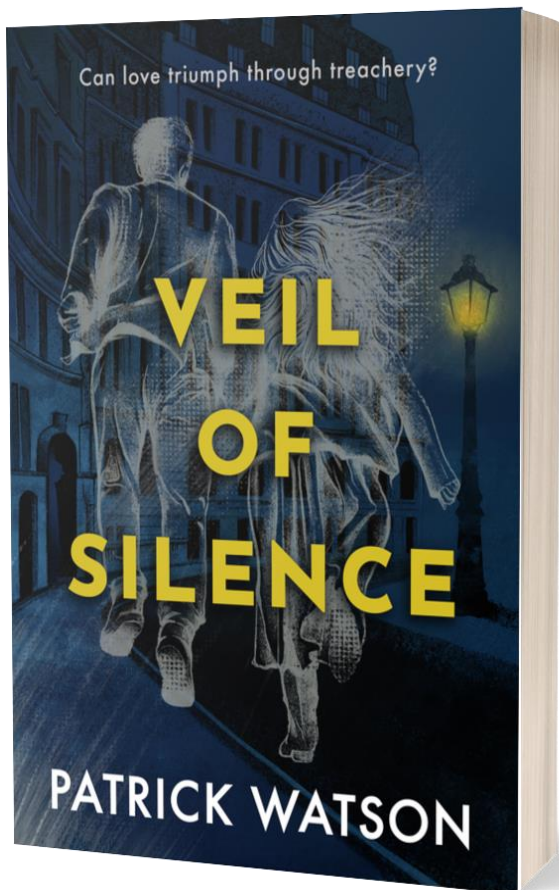

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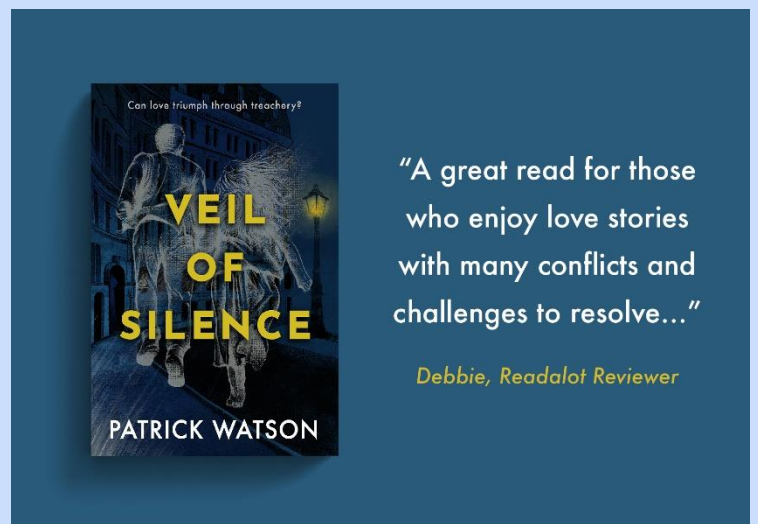
A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR
