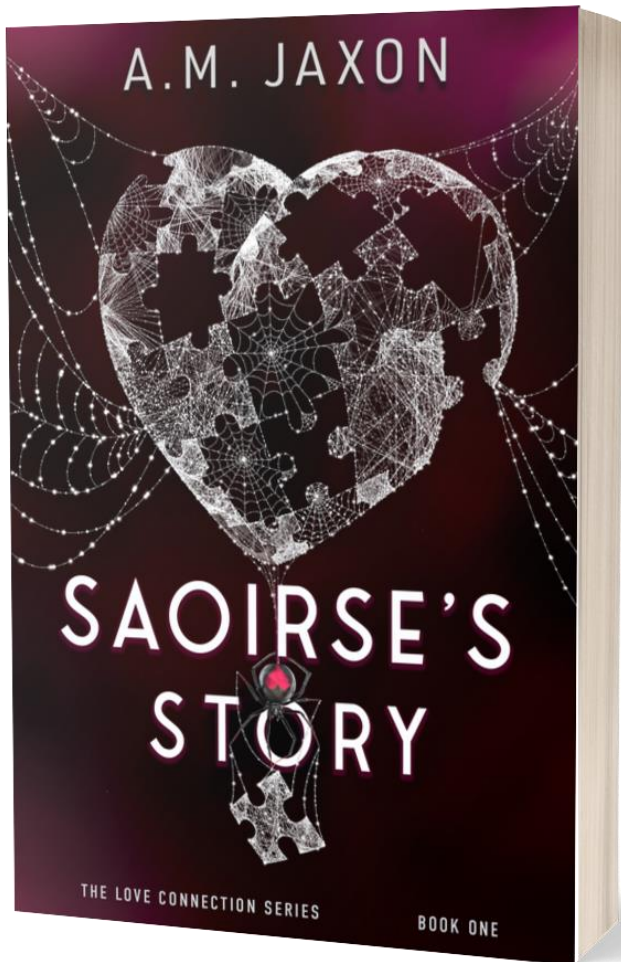


SAOIRSE'S STORY

She earned a PhD from the University of WA and now lives in Perth with her organised but messy husband and a wily Westy.

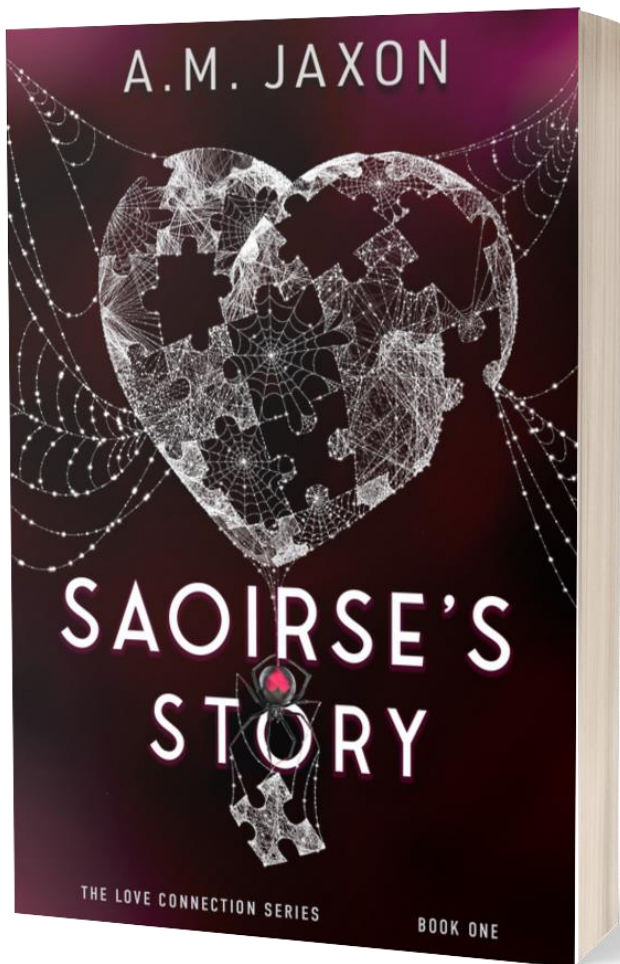

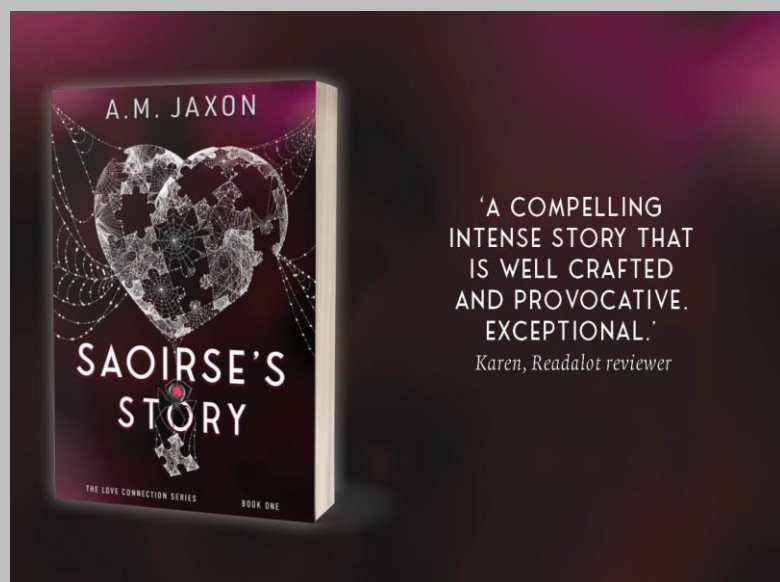
